#### NOTICE OF SUBMISSION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT OF DRAFT AIR POLLUTION RULES, 2000

NOTICE is hereby given in accordance with section 28(1)(a) of the Environmental Management Act, 2000 ("the Act") that the Minister of Environment intends to make Rules entitled "the Air Pollution Rules, 2000" ("the Rules") under sections 26(a), (b), (c), (d), (j), (k), 48, 50, 51 and 81(5)(i) of the Act.

The comments of the public are hereby invited on the draft Rules which will prescribe the procedure to be followed by any person required to apply for an Air Pollution Permit, conditions to be adhered to by any person to whom a permit is granted and the procedures pertaining to the transfer, renewal, revocation and variation of an Air Pollution Permit.

And take notice that the Environmental Management Authority has, pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the Act, established an administrative record that includes a copy of relevant environmental issues, copies of relevant documents and other supporting materials which can assist the public in acquiring a reasonable understanding of the issues involved.
