INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - AUGUST, 2000

General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of August, 2000 was 133.9 showing an increase of 0.1% over the Index for July, 2000.

The Ali Items Index for January-August, 2000 showed an increase of 3.2% over that for January-August, 1999. This compares with an increase of 4.0% observed in the index for January-August, 1999 over the similar period in 1998.

Section Indices

Food: The Index for this section increased from 209.0 in July, 2000 to 209.7 in August, 2000 showing an increase of 0.3%. Within the Food Section there was an increase of 0.9% in the Index for Market items. Contributing significantly to this increase were rising prices of chicken, sweet potatoes and citrus fruits. These price increases were offset by a decrease in the prices of tomatoes, pumpkin, melongene and irish potatoes.

The effect of price changes in this section on the All Items Index was 0.1 point.

Other Sections

A further review of the data for August, 2000 indicated that decreases were recorded for Clothing and Footwear and Household Operations of 0.1%. An increase of 0.1% was recorded for Drink and Tobacco.

The effect of price changes, in this section on the Index was negligible.

Growth in consumer prices in August, 2000 compared with those of August, 1999 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
