# PREQUALIFICATION NOTICE

GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO SECONDARY EDUCATION MODERNIZATION PROGRAMME (SEMP)—DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISION FOR UPGRADE WORKS AT TWENTY SECONDARY SCHOOLS

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO (GORTT) through the Ministry of Education (MOE) has accessed loan funding from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) for a Secondary Education Modernization Programme (SEMP), IDB Loan 1180/OC-TT, the goal of which is to modernize the secondary education sector in Trinidad and Tobago.

One component of the SEMP operation is the technical upgrade of the existing one hundred (100) secondary schools in Trinidad and Tobago. This technical upgrade consists of improvement works to the science laboratories, computer laboratories and libraries. This work is expected to be conducted in five (5) phases of twenty (20) secondary schools. To fulfil its responsibility under this loan, GORTT is inviting expression of interest from consultants from IDB member countries to provide Design and Construction Supervision Consultancy Services for the first phase of twenty (20) secondary schools.
