THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO RACING AUTHORITY gives notice of the following amendments to the Rules of Racing 2000.

5. Powers of the Stewards at Meetings

Include before subsection (1) the following:

"The powers of the Stewards shall commence from 8.00 a.m. on the day fixed for the closing of entries/declarations, and end on the conclusion of the final race on that raceday, subject to the provisions of these rules.".

The above amendments to the Rules of Racing were approved at a meeting of the Trinidad and Tobago Racing Authority held on Thursday 9th November, 2000.
