DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION TO DEPENDANTS OF DECEASED EMPLOYEE

COMPENSATION in the above matter having been deposited with me under section 8 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, the dependants of the said Gregor Moore are hereby required to appear before the Commissioner on Thursday the 9th day of March, 2000, at 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon at the Court House, Port-of-Spain, when the Commissioner shall proceed to determine the distribution thereof.

Proof of relationship of dependants to the deceased workman will be required by the Commissioner to be furnished by claimants at the enquiry. Such proof to be in the form of certificates of birth and of marriage as in the circumstances be necessary.

A claimant for funeral expenses of the deceased must submit and prove his claim to the Commissioner on or before the 9th day of March, 2000.

APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE (Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Kawanhar Doopan, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods, as shall be warehoused by or in the Private Warehouse of Messrs. Northern Auto Supplies Limited—Motor Vehicle Spares and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

SCHEDULE

The building is constructed of concrete blocks and steel with reinforced B.R.C. wire extending to a galvanized roof on the eastern and western sides of the Warehouse. It has a ground floor measuring 29 metres x 20 metres and a mezzanine floor measuring 29 metres x 15 metres. There are two steel doors on the southern side of the building. The premises is bounded on the north by United Independent Manufacturing Company, on the south by a vacant lot owned by Kaleidoscope Properties Limited, on the west by Discount and Auction Warehouse and on the east by Midway Trading Company.
