APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE (Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Kawanhar Doopan, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of section 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereto to be a Private Warehouse for the storage, pending entry for home consumption or export, of the following goods as shall be warehoused by or in the Private Warehouse of Messrs: Caribbean Welding Supplies Limited *viz*: Arc Welding Electrodes of non alloy steel, cored wire of base metal for electric arc-welding and coated rods and cored wire of base metal for soldering, brazing or welding by flame, grinding discs and wheels, wire wheel brushes and welding machines (both diesel and electric), compressors and related spares and such other goods as I may subsequently approve.

An enclosed area measuring 15.18 metres in length by 9.14 metres in width covering an area of 138.74 square metres constructed of concrete blocks with a roof of galvanised iron sheets and having two metal doors, one on the northern side and the other in the south-eastern side. OFFER OF SCHOLARSHIPS IN HINDI BY THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA—ACADEMIC YEAR 2000–2001

THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO invites applications from nationals of Trinidad and Tobago for the award of three (3) Scholarships being offered by the Government of India for studies in Hindi tenable at the Central Institute of Hindi, Agra, India, commencing from August, 2000.

2. Eligibility

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| (a) <i>Certificate in Hindi Language Proficiency</i> | The General Certificate of Education (or recognized equivalent, e.g., CXC General Grades I or II) with passes in five (5) subjects at Ordinary Level (including English Language). |
| (b) <i>Diploma in Hindi Language Proficiency</i> | A Bachelor's degree or its equivalent or basic training in Hindi from a recognized University/Institution. |
| (c) <i>Advanced Diploma in Hindi Language Proficiency</i> | A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University or its equivalent and one of the following:
a Degree of Proficiency in Hindi;
Certificate/Diploma in Hindi Proficiency. |
| (d) <i>Diploma in Hindi Linguistic Applications</i> | A Bachelor's degree from a recognized University or its equivalent, or the required degree of proficiency in the Hindi Language. |

Age Limit

3. The maximum age for admission in any course is thirty-five (35) years. This requirement may be relaxed in deserving cases.
