#### INDEX OF RETAIL PRICES - FEBRUARY, 2000

#### General Index

The All Items Index of Retail Prices calculated from prices collected for the month of February, 2000 was 132.4 showing a decrease of 1.1 point or 0.8% over the Index for January, 2000

The All Items Index for January - February, 2000 showed an increase of 3.3% over that for January-February, 1999. This compares with an increase of 5.6% observed in the Index for January - February 1999 over the similar period in 1998.

#### Section Indices

**Food**: The Index for this section decreased from 211.1 in January, 2000 to 205.8 in February, 2000 showing decrease of 2.5%. Within the Food Section there was a marginal increase of 0.3% in the Index for non-market items, while market items decreased by 27.5 points or 6.5%. Contributing significantly to this decrease were falling prices of chicken, citrus fruits, tomatoes, pumpkin, cabbage and irish potatoes.

The effect of price changes in this section on the All Items Index was 1.2 point.

#### Other Sections

A further review of the data for February 2000 indicated that Health and personal care, recorded an increase of 0.2%.

Growth in consumer prices in February, 2000 compared with those of February, 1999 reflected in various sections of the Index is shown hereunder:-
