Explanatory Note

The object of the Bill is to supplement the appropriation provided for by the Appropriation (Financial Year 2025) Act, 2024 (Act No. 16 of 2024) by authorising the issue from the Consolidated Fund in the sum of three thousand, one hundred and forty three million, nine hundred and eighty three thousand, seven hundred and sixty one dollars (\$3,143,983,761).
