- 3. By Order of the Commission dated 14th July 2023, the first application by JMMBGL for an exemption from the provisions of By-Laws 11 16 of the Take Over By-Laws 2005 in respect of its proposed Share Repurchase Programme was approved with effect from 20th April 2023 for a period of one year;
- 4. By Order of the Commission dated 22nd August 2024, the second application by JMMBGL for an exemption from the provisions of By-Laws 11 16 of the Take Over By-Laws 2005 in respect of its proposed Share Repurchase Programme was approved with effect from 20th April 2024 for a period of one year;

- 1. The Board of Commissioners in considering the application together with the representations by Staff of the Commission pursuant to By-Law 24(2) (c) of the Take-Over By-Laws and being satisfied that is not contrary to the public interest.
- 2. The Board of Commissioners determining that the making of this Order is not prejudicial to the public interest and will not adversely affect the rights or interest of any person.
- **3.** The Board of Commissioners determining in accordance with Section 159(10) (b) of Securities Act, Chapter 83:02 of the Laws of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago, that a hearing is not required for the Order at item 2 above.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- I. The application for an exemption by JMMB Group Limited from By-Laws 11–16 of the Securities Industry (Take-Over) By-Laws, 2005, in respect of the Share Repurchase Programme, is approved, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The exemption shall be for an initial period of one (1) year, with effect from 22nd May 2025 and ending on 21st May 2026; and
 - b. JMMB Group Limited shall submit periodic reports to the Commission on shares acquired pursuant to the Share Repurchase Programme for the duration of the programme.
- II. This Order shall be published in the Trinidad and Tobago Gazette and posted on the Commission's website and a notice of the posting shall be published in two daily newspapers of general circulation in Trinidad and Tobago.


