THE REGULATED INDUSTRIES COMMISSION  
(APPROVAL OF CESS) ORDER, 2025

WHEREAS section 30(1) of the Regulated Industries Commission Act <sup>Preamble</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) provides that the Regulated Industries Commission (hereinafter referred to as “the Commission”) may impose upon service providers, a cess on rates and charges collected by the service providers:

And whereas the Commission has imposed upon service providers, a cess on rates and charges collected by the service providers:

And whereas section 30(2) of the Act provides that no cess imposed shall be of any effect unless and until approved by the Minister by Order:

And whereas section 30(3) of the Act provides, among other things, that the Minister shall satisfy himself that the cess is fair and reasonable having regard to the needs of the Commission:

And whereas the Minister has satisfied himself that the cess imposed is fair and reasonable having regard to the needs of the Commission:

Now, therefore, the Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 30(2) of the Act, orders as follows:
