Made by the Commissioner of Police under section 68(1) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) (CARNIVAL) ORDER, 2025

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Carnival) Order, 2025.
 - 2. In this Order— Interpretation

"Carnival Monday" means Monday 3rd March, 2025; and

"Carnival Tuesday" means Tuesday 4th March, 2025.

3. This Order has effect from Saturday 1st March, 2025 to Carnival Duration Tuesday, inclusive.

PART I

PORT-OF-SPAIN

Division 1—Vehicular Traffic and Parking

- 4. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and Vehicular 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on the following parking roads and on all roads lying within and bounded by them: $\frac{\text{traffic and parking prohibited}}{\text{prohibited}}$

Parking prohibited

- (5) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and midnight and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., parking is prohibited on—
 - (a) the portion of South Quay and the Eastern Main Road, between Vieira Street, Port-of-Spain and Bushe Street, San Juan; and
 - (b) Abattoir Road, between the Priority Bus Route and Beetham Highway.

One-way traffic

- 6. (1) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed along Stone Street, between Wrightson Road and Park Street, in a southerly direction only.
- (2) On Carnival Monday, between the hours of 2.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 6.00 a.m. and 10.00 p.m., vehicular traffic shall proceed along Prada Street, between Maraval Road and Wainwright Street, in a westerly direction only.

Two-way traffic

- 7. (1) On Carnival Monday and on Carnival Tuesday, vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions—
 - (a) around the Queen's Park Savannah, between Casual Corner and Jerningham Avenue;
 - (b) on Observatory Street, between Quarry Street and Belmont Circular Road;
 - (c) on Belmont Circular Road, between Observatory Street and the entrance to the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
 - (d) on Oxford Street, between Observatory Street and Charlotte Street;
 - (e) on Gaston Johnson Street;
 - (f) on Panka Street, between Gaston Johnson Street and Lucknow Street;
 - (g) on Lucknow Street; and
 - (h) on Rapsey Street, between Maraval Road and Wainwright Street.
- (2) On Carnival Tuesday, vehicular traffic may proceed in both a northerly and southerly direction on the northbound carriageway of Maraval Parkway, between Belle-Smythe Street and Wrightson Road.

8. Vehicular traffic proceeding to St. James from Belmont or Route for St. Ann's shall proceed west along Circular Road, north onto Maraval proceeding to Road, west onto Rapsey Street and then onto Barbados Road.

9. Vehicular traffic proceeding to the Port-of-Spain General Route for Hospital on an emergency shall proceed along one of the following vehicles on an routes and shall leave the Port-of-Spain General Hospital along the Port-of-Spain reverse of the route:

- (a) north along Henry Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and then into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (b) from Belmont Circular Road, onto Observatory Street to the Port-of Spain General Hospital;
- (c) north along French Street, onto Maraval Road, east onto Warner Street, south onto Cipriani Boulevard, east onto Melville Street, south onto Dundonald Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and enter the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (d) north along Long Circular Road, south onto Maraval Road, east onto Warner Street, south onto Cipriani Boulevard, east onto Melville Street, south onto Dundonald Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and enter the Port-of-Spain General Hospital;
- (e) west along Lady Young Road, south onto Queen's Park East, then onto Charlotte Street and then into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital via the Maternity Ward Entrance; or
- (f) east along Sackville Street, north onto Edward Street, east onto New Street, onto Charlotte Street and then into the Port-of-Spain General Hospital.

Division 2—Taxi and Maxi-taxi Stands

- 10. This Division has effect between the hours of 2.00 a.m. on Duration Carnival Monday and midnight on Carnival Tuesday.
- 11. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Chacon Street, Long Circular/ between Independence Square South and South Quay, shall operate Wrightson Road from the northern side of Dock Road, between Wrightson Road and the taxi stand entrance to the Port Authority.
- 12. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on South Quay, Diego Martin/ between Broadway and Abercromby Street and the St. James taxi stand Petit Valley/ St. James assigned to Hart Street shall operate from the southern side of Dock taxi stand Road, between Wrightson Road and the entrance to the Port Authority.

"On-call"/ Ice House taxi stand 13. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on the southern side of Independence Square North, between Abercromby Street and St. Vincent Street and on the eastern and western sides of Cipriani Circle, between Independence Square North and Independence Square South shall operate on Charles Street, from Scott-Bushe Street, facing west.

San Fernando/ Chaguanas taxi stand

- 14. Drivers of taxis assigned to taxi stands on Broadway, between South Quay and Independence Square South shall operate the—
 - (a) San Fernando taxi stand, on the northern side of South Quay, between George Street and Nelson Street, facing east; and
 - (b) Chaguanas taxi stand, on the southern side of South Quay, between George Street and Nelson Street, facing east.

Morvant/Trou Macaque taxi stand 15. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on George Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay shall operate on the southern side of the east bound carriageway off the Old St. Joseph Road, east of Piccadilly Street, facing east.

Tunapuna/ Arima/ Sangre Grande taxi stand 16. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Henry Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay shall operate on the southern side of South Quay, between Nelson Street and Duncan Street.

San Juan/ Round-the-Road taxi stand 17. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Charlotte Street, between Independence Square South and South Quay shall operate from the northern side of South Quay, between Nelson Street and Duncan Street.

Belmont taxi stand 18. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand at the corner of Queen Street and Charlotte Street shall operate from Observatory Street and Charlotte Street.

Maraval taxi stand 19. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Duke Street shall operate from the corner of Belleau Road and Belmont Circular Road.

Carenage taxi stand 20. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand at Green Corner shall operate from the corner of Duke Street and Stone Street.

Hospital taxi stand 21. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand at the corner of South Quay and Charlotte Street shall operate from South Quay between George Street and Nelson Street.

St. Ann's taxi stand 22. Drivers of taxis assigned to the taxi stand on Hart Street shall operate from the northern side of Jerningham Avenue, in the vicinity of the Telecommunications Services of Trinidad and Tobago building, facing east.

23. Drivers of Route 1 maxi-taxis shall proceed to the maxi-taxi Route 1 stand on South Quay via the Beetham Highway and exit via the southern $^{
m maxi-taxis}$ side of South Quay, forty metres east of the Beetham Highway.

Division 3—Parade of Bands

24. (1) Bands entering the Queen's Park Savannah Competition Bands Centre shall proceed north along Charlotte Street, west onto Queen's entering and existing

Park West and into the Queen's Park Sayannah

Queen's Park Park West and into the Queen's Park Savannah.

Savannah Competition Centre

- (2) Bands exiting the Queen's Park Savannah shall proceed south along Victoria Avenue and then turn west onto Tragarete Road.
- 25. Bands shall enter Ariapita Avenue by way of Tragarete Road, Bands turn south onto Pole Carew Street, onto Ana Street and then proceed Ariapita east along Ariapita Avenue.
- 26. Bands shall enter the South Quay Competition Centre from Bands Richmond Street, onto South Quay, then exit north onto Broadway, east entering and exiting from along Independence Square South and either proceed north along South Quay Charlotte Street or continue east along Independence Square South, Competition onto Piccadilly Street.
- 27. Bands proceeding to the Soca Drome, at the Hasley Crawford Bands Stadium, shall proceed along Damian Street, south onto Taylor Street, $\frac{\text{entering}}{\text{Soca Drome}}$ west onto Ariapita Avenue, south onto Maraval Parkway on the south bound carriageway only and then into the Hasley Crawford Stadium via Castro Gate.
- 28. (1) Bands shall enter Piccadilly Street Competition Centre by Bands proceeding east along Independence Square South and then north onto exiting and exiting Piccadilly Street.
- Competition (2) Bands shall exit Piccadilly Street Competition Centre by Centre proceeding west onto Park Street, north along Charlotte Street and then west onto Queen's Park West to enter the Queen's Park Savannah.
- 29. (1) Vehicular traffic shall enter the Queen's Park Savannah at Entry and the following locations:

(a) Queen's Park East, near St. Ann's Roundabout; and

(b) Queen's Park West at Casual Corner.

(2) Vehicular traffic shall exit the Queen's Park Savannah at Queen's Park West, at Casual Corner.

- 30. (1) A person attending the parade of bands at the DRAG may park his vehicle at the Queen's Park Savannah during the period commencing three hours prior to the start of the parade of bands and ending three hours after the closure of the parade of bands.
- (2) Parking in the Queen's Park Savannah shall be in accordance with the directions of police officers on duty.

Division 4—Traffic Lights

Operation of traffic lights

31. Automatic traffic lights shall not be in operation between the hours of 2.00 a.m. on Carnival Monday and midnight on Carnival Tuesday.

PART II

TUNAPUNA

Vehicular traffic prohibited

- 32. Vehicular traffic is prohibited on the Eastern Main Road, between El Dorado Road and Tunapuna Road on—
 - (a) Sunday 2nd March, 2025, between the hours of noon and 6.00 p.m.;
 - (b) Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m.;
 - (c) Carnival Monday, between the hours of 3.00. p.m. and midnight; and
 - (d) Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and midnight.

No entry to vehicular traffic

- 33. (1) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Sunday 2nd March, 2025, between the hours of noon and 6.00 p.m., Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and from 2.00 p.m. and midnight from entering—
 - (a) Tunapuna Road, from the Eastern Main Road;
 - (b) Green Street, from Tunapuna Road;
 - (c) Fairley Street, from Sheriff Street;
 - (d) Harrinauth Street, from the Eastern Main Road; and
 - (e) El Dorado Road, between Lackpat Street and the Eastern Main Road.
- (2) Vehicular traffic is prohibited on Carnival Monday, between the hours of 3.00 p.m. and midnight and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 2.00 p.m. and midnight from entering—
 - (a) Tunapuna Road, from the Eastern Main Road;
 - (b) Fairley Street, from Sheriff Street; and
 - (c) El Dorado Road, from the Eastern Main Road.

34. Vehicular traffic proceeding—

Vehicular traffic routes

- (a) east along the Eastern Main Road, shall turn north along Tunapuna Road, east along Green Street, south along El Dorado Road, east along Lackpat Street, south along Harrinauth Street and then turn east to continue along the Eastern Main Road; and
- (b) west along the Eastern Main Road, shall turn north onto El Dorado Road, west along Green Street, south along Fairley Street, west along Sheriff Street, south along Tunapuna Road and then turn west to continue along the Eastern Main Road.
- 35. (1) Parking is prohibited on Carnival Monday, between the Parking hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. and between the hours of 3.00 p.m. prohibited and midnight on—
 - (a) Tunapuna Road, between the Eastern Main Road and Green Street;

- (2) Parking is prohibited on Carnival Monday, between the hours of 3.00 p.m. and midnight and on Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 2.00. p.m. and midnight—
 - (a) Tunapuna Road, between the Eastern Main Road and Green Street;
 - (b) Green Street, between Tunapuna Road and El Dorado Road;
 - (c) Sheriff Street, between Fairley Street and Tunapuna Road; and
 - (d) the Eastern Main Road, between Tunapuna Road and El Dorado Road.
- 36. In the event of an emergency, vehicular traffic proceeding to Emergency the Priority Bus Route shall proceed along the following routes:
 - (a) south along Pasea Road;
 - (b) south along Cemetery Street; or
 - (c) south along Macoya Extension Road.

Ingress route

37. Vehicular traffic proceeding onto the Eastern Main Road, shall proceed north along Pasea Main Road and north along Centenery Street.

Egress route

38. Vehicular traffic proceeding onto the Priority Bus Route, shall proceed south along Pasea Main Road and south along Centenery Street.

PART III

AROUCA

Duration

- 39. This Part has effect on-
 - (a) Sunday 2nd March, 2025, between the hours of 12.00 noon and 6.00 p.m.;
 - (b) Carnival Monday, between the hours of 4.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m.;
 - (c) Carnival Monday, between the hours of noon and midnight; and
 - (d) Carnival Tuesday, between the hours of 1.00 p.m. and midnight.

Vehicular traffic routes

- 40. Vehicular traffic shall proceed—
 - (a) east along the Eastern Main Road, enter the Priority Bus Route at Five Rivers Junction, exit at Second Crossing and continue east along the Eastern Main Road;
 - (b) west along the Eastern Main Road, enter the Priority Bus Route at Second Crossing and exit at Five Rivers Junction:
 - (c) south along Lopinot Road, to continue west, turn west onto the Priority Bus Route and exit onto the Eastern Main Road at Five Rivers Junction;
 - (d) south along Lopinot Road, to continue east, turn east onto the Priority Bus Route and exit onto the Eastern Main Road at Second Crossing;
 - (e) north along Golden Grove Road, shall turn either west onto Old Golden Grove Road, at the first entrance, or east onto Albert Street; and
 - (f) south along Old Golden Grove Road, shall enter Golden Grove Road, at St. Vincent Street, on the eastern side of the road.

49. The muster point shall be located at the Hearty Foods Car Park, Corner Pro Queen Street and Sorzano Street.

Taxi stands relocation

 - (a) Calvary Hill taxi stand, shall park on the eastern side of Prince Street, facing in a northerly direction;
 - (b) Sangre Grande taxi stand, shall park on the southern side of Sorzano Street, facing in an easterly direction;
 - (c) Pinto taxi stand, shall park on the southern side on the corner of Broadway and Cocorite Road, facing in an easterly direction;
