REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

The Emergency Powers Regulations, 2024

ORDER

Made by the Minister of National Security in accordance with paragraph 2 of the Schedule to the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2024

DETENTION ORDER

Whereas it is enacted by Regulation 15 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2024, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2024, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing her from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety or public order or the defence of Trinidad and Tobago, it is necessary to provide for her preventive detention, make an order that she be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2024, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds, Minister of National Security, am satisfied with respect to KEMA MC SHINE also called "KEMA BOSS" of 19th Street, Phase 4, Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain, that it is necessary to provide for her preventive detention with a view to preventing her acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety or public order:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds, Minister of National Security, in exercise of the powers conferred on me, do hereby order that the said KEMA MC SHINE also called "KEMA BOSS" of 19th Street, Phase 4, Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain be detained, and

do hereby authorise the Women's Prison located at Golden Grove Road, Arouca or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said KEMA MC SHINE also called "KEMA BOSS" of 19th Street, Phase 4, Beetham Gardens, Port-of-Spain shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the ground upon which this detention order is made is as follows:

The detainee, KEMA MC SHINE also called "KEMA BOSS", has been credibly identified as a member of, and facilitator for, an organised criminal group known as the Rasta City or 7 Gang, and also affiliated with an organised criminal group known as the M.O.B.S. Gang, and as a person orchestrating, coordinating and enabling violent retaliatory attacks against rival gang members and members of the public with the use of high powered firearms.
