APPOINTMENT OF A PRIVATE WAREHOUSE
(Customs Act, Chap. 78:01)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Comptroller of Customs and Excise under the Customs Act, Chap. 78:01, I, Riad Juman, Comptroller of Customs and Excise, acting under the provisions of sections 2 and 263(2) of the said Act, do hereby appoint the place specified in the Schedule hereunder, to be a Private Warehouse, on behalf of Messrs. Agostini and its Group of Subsidiary Companies (ACADO Foods, ACADO Distribution, AVENTA and Rosco Procom Limited), in which imported goods to wit: creams, cream cheese, grated cheese, butter, frozen vegetables and other such goods as I may subsequently approve may be deposited pending entry for home consumption or export.

SCHEDULE

An enclosed area located in the Acado Distribution Commercial Complex on the southern side of Chootoo Road, south of the Churchill Roosevelt Highway, San Juan.

The area is in the second warehouse to the east after the security checkpoint. The entrance is on the south side of the warehouse. The bonded area is in the northeast corner of the warehouse and is accessed *via* the last sliding door on the right on entering. The area is bounded on the north by an exterior wall of metal and insulation, on the east by additional freezer storage area, on the south by additional freezer and chiller areas and on the west by additional chiller areas. The total area is 18.4 meters by 8.0 meters for a total of 147.2 meters squared.

The bonded area consists of a chain-link fence from floor to ceiling and has a double locked swinging chain-link gate to access the chilled area on the west side, metal panels with insulation on the north and south sides, and a full chain-link fence from floor to ceiling on the east side. The area is further broken up into chiller and freezer areas separated by a sliding metal paneled insulated door. The chiller area is 10.4 meters by 8 meters, which is 83.2 meters squared, and the freezer area is 8 meters by 8 meters which is 64 meters squared.
