INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT

The Shareholders

The Demerara Life Assurance Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited

Opinion

The summary unconsolidated financial statements, which comprise the summary unconsolidated statement of financial position as at December 31, 20X1, the summary unconsolidated statements of comprehensive income, changes in shareholder's equity and cash flows for the year then ended are derived from the audited unconsolidated financial statements of The Demerara Life Assurance Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited (the "Company") for the year ended 31 December 2025. We expressed a qualified audit opinion on those unconsolidated financial statements in our report dated 27 March 2026.

In our opinion, the accompanying summary unconsolidated financial statements are consistent, in all material respects, with the audited unconsolidated financial statements, on the basis described in the Management's Responsibility for the Summary Unconsolidated Financial Statements paragraph below. However, the summary unconsolidated financial statements are misstated to the equivalent extent as the audited unconsolidated financial statements of the Company for the year ended 31 December 2025.

Summary Unconsolidated Financial Statements

The summary unconsolidated financial statements do not contain all the disclosures required by the IFRS Accounting Standards as issued by the International Accounting Standards Board. Reading the summary unconsolidated financial statements and the auditors' report thereon, therefore, is not a substitute for reading the audited unconsolidated financial statements and the auditors' report thereon.

The Audited Unconsolidated Financial Statements and Our Report Thereon

We expressed a qualified audit opinion on the audited unconsolidated financial statements in our report

dated 25 March 2026. The basis for our qualified audit opinion was limitations in documentation supporting management's actuarial models, resulting in our inability to obtain sufficient appropriate audit evidence regarding the material change in assumptions used in the measurement of the expense allocations. We were therefore unable to verify the Insurance Contract - Policyholder Liability balance as at 31 December 2025 and the related impact on the Loss Component on Onerous Contracts reported in the Unconsolidated Statement of Comprehensive Income.

Management's Responsibility for the Summary Unconsolidated Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation of the summary unconsolidated financial statements on the basis described below. Management prepares the summary unconsolidated financial statements in accordance with the IFRS Accounting Standards, but summarizes it by disclosing the unconsolidated summary statements of financial position, comprehensive income, changes in shareholders' equity and cash flows and excluding the notes.

Auditors' Responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on whether the summary unconsolidated financial statements are consistent, in all material respects, with the audited unconsolidated financial statements based on our procedures, which were conducted in accordance with International Standard on Auditing 810 (Revised) - Engagements to Report on Summary Financial Statements.

NOTES TO THE SUMMARY UNCONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
31 DECEMBER 2025

1. Incorporation and Principal Activities:

The Company is incorporated in the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and is registered to carry on all classes of long term insurance business in Trinidad and Tobago. The Company's registered office is located at 136 138 St. Vincent Street, Port of Spain. The company has two wholly-owned subsidiaries - Coblenz Villas Limited and Pleasant Park Properties Limited. The company also has two associated companies - Demerara Mutual Life Assurance Society Limited and Demerara Holdings Limited.

The audited unconsolidated financial statements were approved for issue by the Board of Directors on 27 March 2026.

2. Basis of Preparation:

The summary unconsolidated financial statements are prepared in accordance with criteria developed by management. Under management's established criteria, management discloses the summary unconsolidated statement of financial position, summary unconsolidated statement of income, summary unconsolidated statement of changes in equity and summary unconsolidated statement of cash flows. These summary unconsolidated financial statements are derived from the audited unconsolidated financial statements of The Demerara Life Assurance Company of Trinidad and Tobago Limited for the year ended 31 December 2025, which were prepared in compliance with the IFRS Accounting Standards (IFRSs) as expressed in Note 2 to the notes to the full financial statements for each period presented in the summary.

The summary unconsolidated financial statements do not contain all the disclosures required by International Financial Reporting Standards. Reading the summary unconsolidated financial statements and the auditor's report thereon, therefore, is not suitable for reading the audited unconsolidated financial statements and the auditor's report thereon.

The summary unconsolidated financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the accounting policies set out in "Note 2" of the 2025 audited unconsolidated financial statements consistently applied from period to period except for the effects of new standard that have been implemented during the year.

The areas of critical accounting estimate and judgement as disclosed in "Note 3" of the 2025 audited unconsolidated financial statements, have been expanded to include the effects of IFRS 9 - Financial Instruments and IFRS 17 - Insurance Contracts.

The summary unconsolidated financial statements are presented in Trinidad and Tobago dollars.

The auditor expressed an unmodified audit opinion on the audited unconsolidated financial statements in their report dated 27 March 2026.
