REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2025

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2025

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and, it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to EMMANUEL JONATHAN WALCOTT also called “E MAN” also called “MAD” of Mason Hall, Tobago and Sixth Avenue, Barataria, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety of Trinidad and Tobago:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred on me, do hereby order that the said EMMANUEL JONATHAN WALCOTT also called “E MAN” also called “MAD” of Mason Hall, Tobago and Sixth Avenue, Barataria, shall be detained, and do hereby authorise the

Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said EMMANUEL JONATHAN WALCOTT also called “E MAN” also called “MAD” of Mason Hall, Tobago and Sixth Avenue, Barataria, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, EMMANUEL JONATHAN WALCOTT also called “E Man” also called “Mad”, has been identified as a Shooter/Enforcer for an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) and a gang within the meaning of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021. Intelligence has revoked that he is part of a gang engaging in reprisal killings in public spaces, posing a serious and imminent risk to public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
