REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2025

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2025

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and, it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to DERREL MURRIEN also known as “ONE EYE” of No. 19 Jojo Lane, El Socorro and also of No. 146 Upper 6th Avenue, Malick, Barataria, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety of Trinidad and Tobago:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred on me, do hereby order that the said DERREL MURRIEN also known as “ONE EYE” of No. 19 Jojo Lane, El Socorro and also of No. 146 Upper 6th Avenue, Malick, Barataria, shall be detained, and do hereby

authorise the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said DERREL MURRIEN also known as “ONE EYE” of No. 19 Jojo Lane, El Socorro and also of No. 146 Upper 6th Avenue, Malick, Barataria, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, DERREL MURRIEN also called “ONE EYE” has been credibly identified as an armed enforcer of the “7 Gang” which is an organised criminal gang (‘OCG’) within the meaning of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021. The OCG has access to a cache of firearms and ammunition and is involved in large-scale motor vehicle theft, cocaine trafficking and retailing, and violent home invasions. He has a history of violent encounters with law enforcement, including discharging firearms at officers. He and others intend to imminently intensify their criminal activities to expand their operations and turf which will lead to conflict with other gangs involving high powered firearms in public spaces. The detention of this individual is therefore necessary to disrupt the group’s operational planning and to prevent further acts of violence that pose a clear and present threat to public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2025, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
