THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to to HAKEEM AMZAD ALI of No. 22 Seecharan Street, Cane Farm, Tacarigua, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said HAKEEM AMZAD ALI of No. 22 Seecharan Street, Cane Farm, Tacarigua, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima or

such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said HAKEEM AMZAD ALI of No. 22 Seecharan Street, Cane Farm, Tacarigua, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, HAKEEM AMZAD ALI, has been credibly identified as a member of a kidnapping gang and driver of a vehicle used in kidnappings. He participated in a coordinated operation involving multiple offenders and cross-border elements. His continued liberty poses a real risk of further participation in imminent kidnappings and organised criminal activity to the detriment of members of the public. His detention is necessary to prevent further acts prejudicial to public safety. His detention is necessary to disrupt organised criminal activity, prevent escalation of violence and safeguard public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
