REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE  
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS  
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to JAMYL DE GAZON of Light Pole No. 53, El Socorro Road, Chotoo Drive, El Socorro and also of Chotoo Street, El Socorro and also of Ramcharan Street, El Socorro, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said JAMYL DE GAZON of Light Pole No. 53, El Socorro Road, Chotoo Drive, El Socorro and also of Chotoo Street,

El Socorro and also of Ramcharan Street, El Socorro, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said JAMYL DE GAZON of Light Pole No. 53, El Socorro Road, Chotoo Drive, El Socorro and also of Chotoo Street, El Socorro and also of Ramcharan Street, El Socorro, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, JAMYL DE GAZON has been credibly identified as a leader of the 7 Gang, which is an Organised Crime Group ('OCG') within the definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021. The OCG has access to a cache of high-powered firearms and ammunition and operates in the Barataria areas and is involved in shootings and gang related violence. He and others intend to imminently carry out violent attacks against rival gang members by coordinated shootings using high-powered rifles in public areas in order to expand gang territory. His detention is necessary to disrupt these planned attacks and threats.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
