MADE BY THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE UNDER SECTION 68(1) OF THE
MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(PORT-OF-SPAIN CHILDREN'S CARNIVAL PARADE OF
BANDS) ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (Port-of-Spain Children's Carnival Parade of Bands) Order, 2026.

2. This Order shall have effect in Port-of-Spain from 6.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. on Saturday 14th February, 2026.

3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited on—

Roads closed
and parking
prohibited

- (a) Knox Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (b) Hart Street, between Frederick Street and St. Vincent Street;
- (c) Abercromby Street, between South Quay and Independence Square North;
- (d) Independence Square North, between Henry Street and Edward Street;
- (e) Independence Square South, between Henry Street and Edward Street;
- (f) Broadway, between Beetham Highway and Independence Square South;
- (g) South Quay, between Broadway and Wrightson Road;
- (h) Frederick Street, between Queen's Park West and Independence Square North;
- (i) Pembroke Street, between Gordon Street and Keate Street;
- (j) Queen Street, between Henry Street and Edward Street;
- (k) Duke Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;

- (l) Park Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (m) Oxford Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (n) New Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (o) Gordon Street, between Henry Street and Pembroke Street;
- (p) Keate Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane;
- (q) Henry Street, between New Street and Gordon Street; and
- (r) Queen's Park West, between Queen's Park East and Chancery Lane.

Parking
prohibited

4. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Chancery Lane;
- (b) Dundonald Street, between Queen's Park West and New Street; and
- (c) Albion Street, between Chancery Lane and Stanmore Avenue.

One-way
traffic only

5. Vehicular traffic may proceed in a westerly direction along—

- (a) Albion Street; and
- (b) Gordon Street, between Charlotte Street and Chancery Lane.

Taxi stands

6. Taxis plying for hire shall operate as follows:

- (a) St. Ann's taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the southern side of Queen Street, between St. Vincent Street and Edward Street;
- (b) St. James taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the western side of Edward Street, between Independence Square North and Queen Street;
- (c) Ice House/Broadway/Marine Square taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern and southern sides of Independence Square North, between Edward Street and Wrightson Road;
- (d) San Fernando taxi drivers shall ply for hire from the northern side of South Quay, between George Street and Duncan Street, facing east;

- (e) Chaguanas taxi drivers shall ply for hire from the southern side of South Quay, between George Street and Duncan Street, facing west;
- (f) Long Circular/Wrightson Road taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the southern side of Dock Road, between Post Office Road and Wrightson Road, facing west; and
- (g) Diego Martin/Petit Valley taxi drivers shall ply for hire on the northern side of Dock Road, between Post Office Road and Wrightson Road, facing west.

7. Carnival bands shall proceed from the vicinity of the Central Bank, south along St. Vincent Street, onto South Quay, east along South Quay to Broadway, north along Broadway onto Frederick Street to enter the Queen's Park Savannah *via* the entrance opposite Frederick Street. Band route

8. Without prejudice to any liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked
