THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(POINT FORTIN MILITARY PARADE) ORDER, 2026

PART I

PRELIMINARY

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Citation Provisions) (Point Fortin Military Parade) Order, 2026.
2. This Order has effect on Friday 24th April, 2026, from 9.00 a.m. to Duration 1.00 p.m.

PART II

POINT FORTIN

Vehicular traffic and Parking

3. A driver of a motor vehicle entering Point Fortin shall proceed along— Vehicular traffic routes

- (a) Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, between Bryce Road and Richardson Street;
- (b) Tanner Street, between Bryce Road and the Point Fortin Main Road;
- (c) Point Fortin Main Road, between Reid Road and Tanner Street;
- (d) Techier Main Road, between Handek Street and Fricso Roundabout; and
- (e) Bryce Road, between Tanner Street and Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, Point Fortin.

4. Parking is prohibited on—

- (a) Bryce Road;
- (b) Reid Road;

Parking prohibited

- (c) Atlantic Avenue;
- (d) Mainfield Road;
- (e) Morris Road;
- (f) Church Road;
- (g) Montano Street;
- (h) Nurse Street;
- (i) Alleyne Street;
- (j) School Road;
- (k) alternative routes prescribed under clause 5;
- (l) Clifton Hill Road, between Richardson Street, Volunteer and Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road;
- (m) Sergeant Street;
- (n) George Street; and
- (o) Canaan Road.

Exit from
Point Fortin

5. Vehicular traffic shall proceed along the following alternative routes:

- (a) exit from 2nd Street onto Techier Main Road, onto the Southern Main Road to San Fernando;
- (b) exit Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, east onto Reid Road, north onto the Southern Main Road to San Fernando; or
- (c) exit Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road *via* Tanner Street, west onto Point Fortin Main Road.

Relocation of
Taxi Stand

6. The following taxi stands are relocated:

- (a) the San Fernando Taxi Stand is relocated to the lay-by on the eastern side of Point Fortin Main Road, approximately five hundred metres north of Frisco Roundabout.
- (b) the Cedros and Erin Taxi Stands are relocated to the car park of Point Fortin Catholic Church, on the eastern side of Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, in the vicinity of the intersection of Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road and Reid Road.

PART III

GENERAL

7. (1) Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, vehicles found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed by the Police and impounded and dealt with in accordance with section 108(1)(b) of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act. Removal and impounding of vehicles unlawfully parked Chap. 48:50

(2) Vehicles impounded will be stored at the Point Fortin Borough Corporation Stock Yard at Melville Triangle, Guapo-Cap-de-Ville Road, Point Fortin.
