THE TRAFFIC RESTRICTION (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS)
(ST. JAMES CHILDREN'S CARNIVAL PARADE OF BANDS)
ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Traffic Restriction (Temporary Provisions) (St. James Children's Carnival Parade of Bands) Order, 2026. Citation

2. This Order shall have effect in St. James from 12.00 noon to 7.00 p.m. on Sunday 8th February, 2026. Duration

3. Vehicular traffic and parking are prohibited—

(a) on the Western Main Road, from Long Circular Road to George Cabral Street;

(b) on the westbound lane from Nelson Mandela Park, St. Clair Avenue, along the Western Main Road to Long Circular Road;

(c) on the westbound lane of the Western Main Road, from Roxy Roundabout to Benares Street; and

(d) from the Western Main Road from Long Circular Road to George Cabral Street.

4. Vehicular traffic shall proceed in both directions along the eastbound lane of the Western Main Road from Long Circular Road to Roxy Roundabout. Two-way
traffic only

5. No taxi stands shall operate from the corner of Long Circular Road to George Cabral Street. Taxi stands

6. Carnival bands shall proceed west along the Western Main Road from Long Circular Road to George Cabral Street. Band route

7. Without prejudice to any other liability incurred by the commission of a traffic violation, a motor vehicle found parked in contravention of this Order may be removed, impounded and dealt with in accordance with sections 108 and 109 of the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Act.
