All and singular, that certain piece or parcel of land, situated along Cap-de-Ville Main Road, Point Fortin, in the Ward of La Brea and Guapo, in the County of Saint Patrick, in the island of Trinidad comprising of 1.214 Hectares, 0 roods and 0 perches, bounded on the north by private lands, on the south by Cemetery Block Road, on the west by Cap-de-Ville Main Road and on the east by private lands.
