ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER UNDER SECTION 34A(1) OF
THE BREWERY ACT

THE BREWERY (MANUFACTURE OF BEVERAGES)
ORDER, 2026

1. This Order may be cited as the Brewery (Manufacture of Citation Beverages) Order, 2026.
2. In this Order, “Brewer” means the Caribbean Development Interpretation Company Limited.
3. (1) The Minister authorises the Brewer to manufacture the Authority to manufacture beverages following products on its premises, subject to the terms and conditions in subclause (2):
 - (a) Steam Ultimate Heat, a seltzer-based product in the flavours of pineapple, carabao mango and tropical fruit [(275ml bottles and 295ml cans) 8% of alcohol by volume];
 - (b) Steam Ultimate Vibe, a seltzer-based product in the flavours of watermelon, strawberry and Flavour-Natural White Rum [(275ml bottles and 295ml cans) 5% of alcohol by volume]; and
 - (c) Steam Ultimate Buzz, in the flavours of mixed berry, salted watermelon, mango, yuzi and Flavour-Natural White Rum [(275ml bottles and 295ml cans) no alcohol].
- (2) In manufacturing the beverages referred to in subclause (1), the Brewer shall comply with the following terms and conditions:
 - (a) the manufacturing process shall be submitted to the Officer;
 - (b) twenty-four hours advance notice shall be submitted to the Officer prior to the commencement of the manufacturing process;
 - (c) the dissolving and collecting vessels shall be clearly identified;

- (d) the Brewer shall keep a register and that register shall show particulars pertaining to—
- (i) the quantity and description of raw materials received;
 - (ii) the quantity and description of raw materials issued for the manufacturing process;
 - (iii) the quantity and description of the finished product after bottling; and
- (e) all operations shall be subject to the Officer's supervision.
