REPUBLIC OF TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to SANDERSON DANIEL also known as “BISCUIT” of No. 10 Quinam Road, Siparia, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said SANDERSON DANIEL also known as “BISCUIT” of No. 10 Quinam Road, Siparia, shall be detained at the Remand Prison, Golden Grove, Arouca, or such other place as I may

from time to time direct as the place where the said SANDERSON DANIEL also known as “BISCUIT” of No. 10 Quinam Road, Siparia, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, SANDERSON DANIEL also known as “BISCUIT” has been credibly identified as the operator of an illegal narcotics distribution operation throughout Trinidad and Tobago. The detainee has established links to a number of Organised Crime Groups (‘OCG’) within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021 and several presently detained leaders of those OCGs including his son. Confidential intelligence indicates that the detainee is currently in possession of military grade high-powered assault rifles and high-velocity ammunition which he and others intend to imminently use to carry out a public killing of a drug world rival in order to take over control of a competing illegal narcotics distribution operation.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
