THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to RUDRANATH GAYAPERSAD of No. 2 Chester Street, Debe, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said RUDRANATH GAYAPERSAD of No. 2 Chester Street, Debe, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima, or

such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said RUDRANATH GAYAPERSAD of No. 2 Chester Street, Debe, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, RUDRANATH GAYAPERSAD has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group ('OCG') within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, operating in the Southern district which is involved in the sale and distribution of firearms, ammunition and illegal narcotics. The detainee was recently found in possession of a quantity of illegal narcotics and ammunition and issued threats to kill members of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service on being released from custody. Confidential intelligence indicates that the detainee is the stash man for the OCG which is engaged in turf wars with other rival OCGs and that he and others intend to make good on the threats issued to the members of the TTPS by firearm attack in public spaces. The detainee has a prior record of violent and criminal behaviour and his continued liberty is a threat to public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
