THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to AQUIL JEREMIAH R. ARMSTRONG also known as “KILLY KILLY” of 34, Picton Street, Woodbrook, Port-of-Spain and also of 7, Calvary Hill, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said AQUIL JEREMIAH R. ARMSTRONG also

known as “KILLY KILLY” of 34, Picton Street, Woodbrook, Port-of-Spain and also of 7, Calvary Hill, East Dry River, Port of Spain, shall be detained at the Remand Prison, Golden Grove, Arouca, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said AQUIL JEREMIAH R. ARMSTRONG also known as “KILLY KILLY” of 34, Picton Street, Woodbrook, Port-of-Spain and also of 7, Calvary Hill, East Dry River, Port-of-Spain, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, AQUIL JEREMIAH R. ARMSTRONG also known as “KILLY KILLY” has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, known to law enforcement as the “Aliens/Seven Gang”. The OCG has access to a cache of firearms and ammunition and is engaged in violent armed robberies, break-ins, larceny, shootings and retaliatory attacks on rival gangs. The detainee is an enforcer for the OCG. Confidential intelligence indicates that the detainee and a related party have recently issued threats on social media to seek revenge against persons unknown for the killing of two of their relatives. The detainee and others possess the means to carry out such retaliatory attacks and intend to imminently execute these plans in public spaces using high-powered firearms.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
