THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to KEEGAN ANTHONY GILL also known as “BEAGLE” of Cassava Alley, Point d’Or, La Brea, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said KEEGAN ANTHONY GILL also known as “BEAGLE” of Cassava Alley, Point d’Or, La Brea, shall be detained at the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at

Santa Rosa, Arima, or such other place as I may from time to time direct as the place where the said KEEGAN ANTHONY GILL also known as “BEAGLE” of Cassava Alley, Point d’Or, La Brea, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, KEEGAN ANTHONY GILL also known as “BEAGLE” has been credibly identified as an active participant in an organised criminal network engaged in the coordinated theft, transportation, concealment and disposal of stolen motor vehicles in the La Brea and San Fernando districts. The detainee participated in the organised theft of three MG motor vehicles from the Massy Motors compound at Ciperio Street, San Fernando, including vehicles intended for use by the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service. The offences were carefully planned and executed by multiple participants acting in concert and the detainee forms part of a wider organised vehicle-theft network responsible for the acquisition, movement and concealment of stolen motor vehicles. Intelligence indicates that members of this network remain active and continue to pose a significant threat to public safety, commercial enterprises and the operational capability of the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
