THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to DENNIS MASON of Light Pole No. 6, Eastern Quarry, Laventille, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, hereby order that the said DENNIS MASON of Light Pole No. 6, Eastern Quarry, Laventille, shall be detained in the Eastern Correctional Rehabilitation Centre located at Santa Rosa, Arima or such other place

as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said DENNIS MASON of Light Pole No. 6, Eastern Quarry, Laventille, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, DENNIS MASON has been credibly identified as a member of an Organised Crime Group ('OCG') within the legal definition in the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, which is known as the Nine Gang. The OCG has access to a cache of high-powered firearms and ammunition and is engaged in home invasions, drug and firearm trafficking, shootings and robberies. The detainee is a stash man, distributor of narcotics and an enforcer for the OCG. The detainee and others have been linked by confidential intelligence to imminent acts to expand their territory involving the use of firearms in public spaces against their rivals and further home armed invasions.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to disrupt these plans and prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
