THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE  
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS  
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing him from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention, make an order that he be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to DURELLE RAYMOND also known as “SHORTO” of Light Pole No. 59, Celestine Trace, Maraval, that it is necessary to provide for his preventive detention with a view to preventing him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred on me, do hereby order that the said DURELLE RAYMOND also known as “SHORTO” of Light Pole No. 59, Celestine Trace, Maraval, shall be

detained at the Remand Prison located at Golden Grove, Arouca, or such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said DURELLE RAYMOND also known as “SHORTO” of Light Pole No. 59, Celestine Trace, Maraval, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, DURELLE RAYMOND also known as “SHORTO” is a member of an Organised Crime Group (‘OCG’) within the legal definition of the Anti-Gang Act, 2021, that operates in the Maraval, Paramin and North Coast areas of Trinidad. The OCG has confirmed access to a cache of high-powered firearms and ammunition and has been engaging in territorial expansion resulting in public shootings, murders and trafficking of firearms, ammunition and narcotics. The detainee although presently incarcerated is still giving orders coordinating firearm and narcotic trafficking, shootings, murders and extortion activities of the OCG. He and others plan to carry out retaliatory shootings against rival gangs in public spaces using high-powered firearms and high-velocity rounds. His detention is necessary to disrupt the supply chain of illegal firearms and to prevent further acts that pose a clear and present threat to public safety.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent him from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
