THE EMERGENCY POWERS REGULATIONS, 2026

ORDER

MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOMELAND SECURITY IN ACCORDANCE
WITH PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE SCHEDULE TO THE EMERGENCY POWERS
REGULATIONS, 2026

DETENTION ORDER

WHEREAS it is enacted by regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the provisions of the Schedule shall have effect for the purpose of the preventive detention of persons:

And whereas it is provided in paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that the Minister may, if satisfied with respect to any person that, with a view to preventing her from acting in any manner prejudicial to public safety and, that it is necessary to provide for her preventive detention, make an order that she be detained and stating concisely the grounds for such detention:

And whereas it is further provided in paragraph 3(1) of the Schedule of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, that any person in respect of whom a detention order is in force may be arrested without warrant by any police officer and may be detained in such place and under such conditions as the Minister may from time to time direct:

And whereas I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, am satisfied with respect to KISELLE RAMDIAL of No. 2 Swan Quarry Road, Valencia, that it is necessary to provide for her preventive detention with a view to preventing her from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety:

Now, therefore, I, the Honourable Roger Alexander, Minister of Homeland Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me, do hereby order that the said KISELLE RAMDIAL of No. 2 Swan Quarry Road, Valencia, shall be detained at the Women's Prison, Golden Grove, or

such other place as I may from time to time direct, as the place where the said KISELLE RAMDIAL of No. 2 Swan Quarry Road, Valencia, shall be detained and so kept in lawful custody.

TAKE NOTICE that the grounds upon which this detention order is made are as follows:

The detainee, KISELLE RAMDIAL, has been credibly identified as a member of an organised criminal network specialised in human trafficking, the illegal trafficking of firearms, and related criminal activity. The detainee manages the coordination of residential and commercial facilities used for the concealment of trafficked individuals and the distribution of illegal firearms. The detainee's activities contribute directly to the logistical infrastructure used by the network to facilitate violent criminal acts and ensure the operational security of the enterprise. The detainee is a member of an organised criminal group involved in gang-related violence and exploitation. Her continued liberty poses a credible and foreseeable risk to the public, as it sustains the infrastructure through which firearms and trafficked persons are controlled.

A Preventive Detention Order pursuant to regulation 14 of the Emergency Powers Regulations, 2026, is necessary to prevent her from acting in a manner prejudicial to public safety.
